Aptly applies principles of consultation to make group discussions.


TeamMx Regional Coordinators. We assign coordinators to a specific region and prescribe a local within that region from which they work to hosts stakeholders, that through dialogue to determine community needs within the framework of a proposed, implemented public policy, a policy designed to garner benefit from a globalizing world community. This ground-up approach to create criteria for sustainable development provides community stakeholders opportunity to involve themselves in planning and decision-making as described below.

Cohesive Globalized Public Policy. We use a bottom-up approach to create development policy that requires input from stakeholder community members. The aim is to change from current policy criteria that focus on materialistic outcomes to one that's representative of the total reality of the human experience. To achieve this, we focus on humankind's commonalities—its oneness as a species, religious orientations, vast diversity, consciousness and spiritual awareness, and humanity's inherent infinite creative abilities. It is by this process that the 'voice of a diverse unheard' becomes known.

TeamMx Regional Coordinators receives input through their collaborative efforts with local stakeholders and community members to address their policy concerns and benefits derived if implemented. The key idea behind this process is to educate, explain, build awareness, and advise on the need for the community to involve itself in policy planning and decision-making, processes designed to lay the proper foundation required for creating and implementing a globalized public policy unique to community stakeholders in ways it best serves their collective interests.

TeamMx Regional Coordinators functions are non-discriminatory, non-administrative and non-managerial, meaning that they operate without 'power of authority', but act in the capacity of their position as an exponent of collaboration and consultation to assist stakeholders in their efforts to make those decisions that benefit their respective communities.

Coordinators provides input to the Field Advisory where assessment takes place and documentation completed. It is along these lines that Regional Coordinators have an established and interrelated working relationship with the Field Advisory based on mutual respect and trust, common interests, and unconditional support. The information received by the Advisory from Field Coordinators we consider being factual, evidence-driven, resource-based, and that it represents ground level coordinated effort to gain the best information possible from stakeholder communities.
